NDP 18 MINUTES – Members approved the minutes of the 26 November 2020 subject to 2 amendments at NDP 13 and NDP14.

NDP 19 MATTERS ARISING -

 Visioning Exercise Video was near completion. Narration editing was required prior to release onto the Council Website and Facebook.

- D Gluck reported that future Neighbourhood Planning would be influenced by the Local Plan due for consultation in 2021.

Built Environment/Heritage

-list of areas outside the conservation area that might have heritage value – including the 1 or 2 areas on the periphery of the existing conservation area

-list of non-listed buildings of possible heritage value, e.g. The Barn

- Green/Natural Environment

-list of 'local green spaces' worthy of protection from development (NB indicate also if in need of enhancement)

-list of 'opportunity sites' with potential for use/development for green/open space purposes

- Community Facilities

-list of facilities that should be protected in community use

-list of community facilities currently missing from the parish

-list of 'opportunity sites' with potential for use/development for community facility purposes

- Economic Development

-list of 'opportunity sites' with potential for use/development for economic development purposes, including a hotel

Traffic/Transport/Travel

-list of routes for new public rights of way (PROW), e.g. missing links in existing PROW network

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-list of routes for new cycle paths

-list of 'opportunity sites' with potential for use/development for traffic etc. purposes, e.g. for a new car park

NDP20 STEERING GROUP MEMBERSHIP – D Gluck – there were 7 potential new members for the group.

NDP 21 LOCALITY TECHNICAL SUPPORT PACKAGES – MD/DG –

M Dando reported that Locality Technical Support Packages information for supporting Neighbourhood Plan preparation had been circulated to members.

He had narrowed the packages to 3 as follows: -

1. Housing Needs Assessment – Discussions and updates would be required from SDC Planning. More housing is needed in the town.

2. Master Planning – The Town Centre would be looked at regarding how the

Neighbourhood Plan policies/actions could complement SDC initiatives in the future. An SDC Planning update would be required to avoid duplication.

3. Design including Design Codes – Technical Support would look at the Conservation Area and make suggestions and advise on design and what to include in the plan.

ACTION – D Gluck to work with TTC to apply to Locality initially for Design including Design Code support and to set up Zoom meeting with SDC officers in advance of this and other application.
