

A NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN FOR TADCASTER?

Your Town Council is considering undertaking a Neighbourhood Development Plan – that would be a legal document which would form our very own chapter of the Selby district Local Plan. In other words, it would both set the scene for how our town develops over the next 15 years as well as containing policies against which every application for planning permission in Tadcaster would be judged.

Neighbourhood Plans are usually led by Town or Parish Councils but also involve as many local people as possible, whether through consultation or by individuals volunteering to help out.

The very first stage in deciding whether to take on such a task – which could take two years or more to complete – is to get the views from our community about what such a Plan should focus on. Our initial meetings have developed an initial set of ideas and we would like your views please on if these are the right priorities for the town, if we missed anything out, or if you have anything else you'd like to share with us right now.
