SHORT WALKS AROUND TADCASTER Oxton Hall



**FOLLOW
THE ROUTE
ANTI-
CLOCKWISE**

2 miles: 1 hour

Pack: high vis as walking on a drive and a short distance of road with no pavement

At the bus park, turn your back to the road and head for the far left-hand corner, with the medical centre on your left. Go through the kissing gate and follow the sign to Ouston Lane.

Continue on the path through the field and go through a second gate. Then follow the path up the hill.

At the end of the path go straight on up Oxton lane – don't take the immediate right which is Ouston Lane.

Go over the A64 flyover and continue straight on down the hill. There is a path to the right of the road here. You then come to the gates of Oxton Hall on your left.

Take the drive through the park and follow the permissive path through the grounds of the Hall. Keep right when you get to the black metal gates, go through a wooden gate and along the straight drive.

When you get to the large boulders at the end, turn left and follow the A64 again. When you get to the end of the path, keep on the left of the road and in 150 yards you enter the wood on another permissive path. Go as far as you can on the path and then complete the walk on the pavement back to the bridge.

The owner of Oxton Hall requests that you stay on the permissive tarmac path through the estate and do not leave it to examine the house.
